



# Communities that Care

**Who Cares? Scotland**, a national voluntary organisation, will be working with the school to deliver their Communities that Care project, improving school experiences for care experienced pupils whilst creating an empathic and inclusive environment where care experienced people have a sense of belonging within their community.

The term "care experienced" refers to anyone who has been, or is currently in care. This care may have been provided in many different settings, such as: Kinship care, Looked after at home, Residential care, Foster care, Secure care and Adoption.



## **The class will participate in an interactive session that will discuss:**

- The meaning of care experience and issues faced by care experienced pupils.
- What support is available to care experienced people.
- How to create a more inclusive environment for all pupils.
- How the wider community can support care experienced people.



## **Who Cares will also offer:**

- Drop-in sessions for all pupils who wish to find out more about care experience and support available.
- Participation groups
- Awareness raising sessions to the wider community.
