# **Kic Forms**

Kic forms will be distributed on your child's first day at school. It is critical that these are returned immediately to allow your child to take part in outdoor learning around the community and take part in class trips. Please return these as quickly as you can.

#### Uniform

Now that the pandemic has passed, we are very keen to return to all children wearing school uniform every day.

This does not need to be Brunstane branded clothing, but we request that all children P1-7 wear a blue jumper or cardigan and/or a white shirt, blouse or polo shirt. We asks that pupils wear dark trousers, skirts, joggers or leggings and darks shoes or trainers. The school has a large stock of pre-loved uniforms in good condition for anyone who could use them.

# PE Kit

All pupils will be provided a school PE top. Pupils may bring in their own should they wish. We request no football shirts.

Please provide your child with shorts/joggers and suitable sports shoes.

# **Stationary**

All necessary stationary will be provided. Please do not send your child to school with a huge pencil case as children are often upset when they lose items from these and they can often be a distraction during lessons.

# **Toys**

Please do not send your child to school with toys. Again, these often get lost or broken which is upsetting. The school cannot take any responsibility for any toys or trading cards brought to school.

## **Medicine/Medical Forms**

The school cannot dispense any medicine unless it is in its original packaging and a medical form has been provided to the school office.

All medication was sent home before the summer and the school now holds no medicine for ay pupils.

Please drop off any medicine to the front office and complete a medical form at the front office.

Please ensure your child has two in-date inhalers in school if they require them.

#### **Car Park**

Please note that the school car park is for staff and blue badge holders only. The car park gates will be closed throughout the school day.

#### **ParentPay**

ParentPay, will now be the only payment method at Brunstane Primary School for all payments including school meals, milk and school trips. The school office is no longer able to accept cash payments.

ParentPay is also the system used to select school dinner choices. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals you must now book it through ParentPay. If you have not already activated your account a letter with Activation Information will be sent home with your child this week.

# Cost of school meals

The City of Edinburgh Council has increased the cost Price of meals to £2.30.

## Free School Meals/School Grant

Meals in school are free until children are in Primary 5 but applying for a school grant also allows your child to get free milk, support to buy school clothing and school holiday payment. For every child who successfully gains this entitlement, the school also gets £1200 funding per child per year. This totals £8400 in your child's primary school life and helps us enrich the quality of school experience for your child. To put in context, 3 pupils who are entitled to this grant allow us to employ a full time Pupil support assistant to directly support in class learning for three months. If you have any questions or difficulties in completing this form, please come to our school office and we can help. The application is a simple online form, please visit the City of Edinburgh's website and search free school meals. Office staff will be happy to support you if you need help.

#### **Environment**

We would continue to welcome community support to further upgrade our playground environment. Help sourcing loose parts items including tyres, crates, piping, guttering, wooden cable rolls, tarpaulins, palettes, plastic jugs, saucepans, watering cans and buckets would be greatly appreciated.

# **Parent Contact Details**

It is vitally important that we have up to date contact information for all our families. If you move house or change phone number, please inform the school. It is also extremely helpful to have a working email address as a back up to these methods so that we can send letters home quickly when required. Please return the data form being sent home this week.

## **Parking**

We continue to receive reports about cars parked in a dangerous manner at drop off times. We would like to politely request that parents do not park on pavements or block driveways. Please obey all road markings in order to ensure pupil safety.

# Dogs

Please remember that dogs are not allowed anywhere on the school campus.

## <u>Nuts</u>

Please remember that no food products containing nuts should be brought into school. We have a number of pupils across the school who have allergies and they could become extremely unwell if this rule is not observed.
