Interfaith

Primary three to seven were treated to an Interfaith Roadshow on the 29th of November. Representatives from the Christian, Muslim, Jewish, Buddhist and Bahai communities were there. The children went to see and handle artefacts from all of these religions and ask any questions they had. We also had representatives from the Equalities and Diversities department of the police service to share their message of treating all people with respect. Learner Participation Groups

We have had our first round of learner participation groups this term. In the first meeting the groups laid out a vision for what they would like the group to achieve. The Digi Squad discussed how to support teachers and learners with our iPads and the potential for a digital day. The Equalities Team thought about what lessons they have experienced that had an impact on them and which ones they would like shared with the whole school to promote Equality at Brunstane. The Playground Group will be looking at a playground charter to keep everyone safe and happy on our new playground equipment. The Rights Respecting Group discussed what they already knew about rights and focused on right to a name and created name badges to make a display. Sports Leaders will be creating a questionnaire to discover what sports are played by all the children at Brunstane and what sports would they like to see at our school. The Junior Road Safety Stars have been creating posters to raise awareness about safely crossing roads for both pedestrians and drivers! We will update you on all the great work our Learner Participation Groups get up to throughout the year.

Eco group

We had a very successful Eco group meeting, setting out our aims and visions for what we would like to achieve for the year. Our main goal is to make Brunstane as eco friendly as possible! I was so impressed at the ideas and passion for the environment that everyone shared. We even came up with a catchy slogan - 'Think green, think Brunstane'. Our next step is to gather feedback about what sustainable practices are happening in Brunstane and what we could do to improve. I can't wait for our eco journey to continue!
