Dear Parents/Carers,

I hope this finds you well.

It has been absolutely fantastic to have the majority of our pupils back at Brunstane over the last few weeks, allowing us to enjoy all of our traditional Christmas events back together. Huge thanks to all of the families who have come along to these to join in all of the festive fun.

The one group of our pupils yet to return are our nursery children. We are delighted to let you know that **our nursery pupils will be returning to Brunstane on Monday 15th of January.**

To facilitate the return of our nursery pupils, our P1, P1/2, P2, P3, P4 and P4/5 classes will be moved back to their traditional rooms over the Christmas holiday. This means that when these pupils return on Tuesday 9th January, they will be returning to a different classroom with different lining up and dismissal points. P3a, P4, P4/5 will be lining up and dismissing from the front of the tower block, whilst P3b and P1, P1/2, and P2 will line up in the infant playground.

Whilst our nursery children will return to Brunstane on Monday 15th January, they will continue to attend Moffat for the first week back (Tuesday 9th - Friday 12th) with bus arrangements and timings remaining as before the holidays.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank all our Brunstane families for their patience over this difficult period and to our staff team who have committed huge amounts of their own time to minimise disruption for our children and ensure that they received the very best teaching, learning and play experience possible.

Playtime arrangements for returning pupils

With all of our pupils returned to their traditional areas of the school, all pupils will revert to their normal playgrounds. Nursery pupils will access the nursery garden, P1-2 will use our infant playground and P3-7 will access our wider playground.

The vast majority of our playground is back open to us with the exception of a small area of the back field. This is still closed until the grass can be reseeded and the goals repaired in time for spring.
